Dissipating on 10 October 2016, Hurricane Matthew was the most powerful storm of the 2016 Atlantic Hurricane Season, creating estimated damages of \$10.3 billion across the Southeastern United States.

As directed by Federal Emergency Management Agency via local government agencies, Irby mobilized its crews to support emergency power restoration efforts in the storm's wake, providing a caravan of specialized personnel and equipment for rapid response. By month's end October 2016, Irby had restored power as directed.
