Serving six utility districts including the Salt River Project, this line consisted of 52.4 miles of single circuit triple bundle conductor (up to 1,400 MW capacity) on approximately 205 self-supporting lattice steel towers.

Foundation work for the project was performed by fellow Quanta Services subsidiary company Can-Fer Construction, and the helicopter leadline was performed by Air2, LLC. The project was successfully delivered in May of 2008.
