2026 SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

About the Scholarship:

Quanta Services and Entergy have partnered to recruit for the Louisiana Resiliency Project. The goal of the scholarship is to increase interest in the power delivery trade in our state.

Applicant Eligibility:

- Have residence in Louisiana
- Submit a completed application packet.
- Be accepted into the Northwest Lineman Center's Electrical Lineworker Program. (NLC ELP).

Amount and Use:

- There are two scholarships available per year that cover full tuition, application fees, lab fees, CDL costs, tools associated with the Electrical Lineworker Program. The scholarship will also cover housing provided by Collegiate Housing while attending NLC. The student is responsible for all other expenses associated with the program such as living expenses.
- Scholarship funds must be applied to a NLC ELP term that begins following the award of the scholarship. Scholarship funds may not be deferred beyond this time frame.
- Scholarship funds will not be issued directly to the student but will be applied toward the student's tuition and tool balance owed.
- Upon graduation from NLC ELP, students must commit to no less than two years of employment with a Quanta Company. The successful graduate must also comply with and complete any pre-employment drug screen, background check or new hire screening process required by the hiring Quanta Company.
- Students who do not fulfill the terms of the scholarship will be responsible for reimbursing Quanta Services, Inc. the full amount of the scholarship funds.

Selection Criteria:

- Cumulative GPA (2.0 or above preferred).
- One- to two-page letter (typed, 12-point font) by student stating why he/she would like to pursue a career in linework, how this scholarship will help, and how he/she plans to pay for living expenses and additional costs while at NLC.
- Two reference letters from a school counselor, principal, teacher, coach or previous employer.

Scholarship Selection Committee:

- Selection of candidate will be managed through Quanta Services and Entergy.

Application Packet Components:

- Completed application form.
- One- to two-page letter (typed, 12-point font) by student stating why he/she would like to pursue a career in linework, how this scholarship will help, and how he/she plans to pay for additional costs while at NLC.
- Two reference letters from a school counselor, principal, teacher, coach or previous employer.
- Official high school or college transcript submitted to NLC.
- Proof the admissions process has been started with NLC Electrical Lineworker Program for the calendar year of scholarship.

Deadline and Submission Information:

- July 14, 2026 deadline.
